# ORVAL HUFFMAN



Orval Huffman's coaching career spanned 28 years including stints at Greensburg Community High School, Edgewood High School, Bedford High School, and as the 1<sup>st</sup> head baseball coach at Bedford North Lawrence High School. His career record stands at 420 wins and 155 losses. This includes the following championships:

- \* 10 Sectionals
- \* 3 Regionals
- \* 2 Semi-States
- \* 2 Final Four appearances in '75 and '77

He also served as the head coach for the South All Stars in 1977. He was inducted into the *Indiana High School Baseball Hall of Fame* in 1987.

## DEFINITIONS OF THE GAME

**Cour\*te\*sy Run\*ner** [kur-tuh-see ruhn-er] (noun) :

The IHSAA adopted the optional use of a courtesy runner for the pitcher and catcher during all authorized IHSAA baseball contests, including the state tournament. A player that has not participated in the game can serve as a courtesy runner. The same individual runner may not be used for both positions.
